1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards. The particular accounting policies adopted are described below.

(a) Basis of Accounting

These accounts have been prepared in accordance with the historical cost convention.

(b) Turnover

Turnover represents the aggregate of amounts receivable for services and goods supplied in the ordinary course of business, excluding value added tax.

(c) Fixed assets and depreciation

All fixed assets are stated at cost.

For all other intangible & tangible fixed assets, depreciation is provided to write off their cost or valuation on a reducing balance basis over their estimated useful lives, which are considered to be -

Goodwill	- 4% reducing balance
Freehold Buildings	- 4% reducing balance
Motor Vehicles	- 25% reducing balance
Fixtures & Fittings	- 15% reducing balance
Improvements to the Property	- 4% reducing balance
Freehold Land	- NIL

(d) Stock

Foods & Drinks are valued at the lower of cost or net realisable value.

(e) Deferred Taxation

Provision is made for taxation liabilities arising from the allocation to items to different periods for taxation and for accounting purposes at the corporation tax rates anticipated to be in force at the time each deferred liability will ultimately crystallise, to the extent that it is probable that a liability will crystallise in the future.
